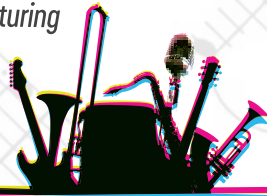

Comedian Kathleen Madigan’s 32-year comedy career is showing no signs of slowing down. Madigan has been touring 250 nights a year on the road and has risen from performing in comedy clubs to performing in marquee theaters with sold out shows. She’s squeezed in over 40 appearances on late night talk shows and multiple comedy specials airing on Netflix, Comedy Central and HBO. She also

recently joined Jerry Seinfeld on his Netflix show “Comedians in Cars Getting Coffee” and made the most of the pandemic by launching a podcast, “Madigan’s Pubcast,” on all streaming outlets. Recently asked if her career was planned, she said, “No, like that guy in the Joy of Painting used to say, it was a happy accident. This whole thing just started out as a reason to drink and wow, what a great drinking accident.”

Madigan has performed internationally at festivals in theaters in Ireland, England, Hong Kong, Australia and has filmed seven Montreal Gala Shows at the Montreal Comedy Festival for CBC TV. “I never realized how middle America I am until performing overseas. It all works but needs some tweaking when the crowd isn’t all Americans. It’s a good challenge and made me a better comedian.” She also has joined numerous USO trips to entertain troops around the globe, including Iraq and Afghanistan.

She’s won the American Comedy Award for “Best Female Comedian” and the Phyllis Diller award for “Best Female Comedian.” She has written and produced for Lewis Black’s “Root of All Evil” on Comedy Central and done multiple USO tours in Iraq and Afghanistan. “The USO shows are the best. Trust me, no crowd is as appreciative and fired up to see any entertainer. I’m glad I have the chance because God knows I don’t wanna have to do their job!”

Madigan is an advocate and fundraiser for Cystic Fibrosis and Autism.

Originally from St. Louis, Missouri, Madigan splits her time between her home in the Missouri Ozarks and LA.

DR. MARVIN C. GOLDSTEIN

Marvin C. Goldstein, D.D.S., F.A.C.D., F.I.C.D. was a product of his heritage and his faith. He was devoted to his profession and to his family—immediate and extended. A man of his community, he gave of himself unstintingly to help make it the best it could be. Marvin’s philosophy about doing good things, simply put, was “because it’s the right thing to do.”



might not be completed, he knew he had to make the effort. But Marvin’s greatest passion was people. His community involvement knew no bounds. Civic leaders, regardless of faith, color, gender or political persuasion, turned to him as a man of courage and conviction. It was not only for financial help but also to seek his advice and counsel on subjects ranging from practicality to

those of more esoteric nature.

Active in more than 20 dental organizations, he devoted 48 years as a volunteer to the Ben Massell Dental Clinic in Atlanta where he was Chief of Staff Emeritus at the time of his death. He served as President of no less than eight dental, civic, religious or volunteer organizations, was Chairman of the board of ten such activities and participated as a worker in countless other associations. In addition to being a Clinical Professor of Orthodontics at the Medical College of Georgia School of Dental Medicine, he presented more than 200 lectures in the U.S. and abroad and contributed extensively to the literature.

His efforts to assist students trying to enter schools of higher education and the professions are legend. Those concerns were outdone only by the friendship he offered as they traveled the road of life. And, yet, this plate he had been served—so full of doing and giving to and for others—always had special room for his devoted wife and helpmate, Rita, and their five children and their families.

His plethora of activities make the point that one does what one wants to do and that time can be found to participate in total life-cycle experiences. Though realizing that many endeavors

The Thomas P. Hinman Medallion

The Thomas P. Hinman Medallion is considered to be one of the highest honors bestowed in dentistry. The Medallion is not only an honor to the recipient, but also an honor to the memory of the man for whom it was named.

Julian Harris, the late world-famous sculptor, is responsible for the Medallion being a work of art. Mr. Harris, whose creations are seen in leading museums and in public buildings and squares across the nation, did diligent research before designing the Medallion. The primary motif is the official insignia of dentistry. The Medallion also includes the motto of the Hinman Dental Society, “Magna Est Veritas Et Praevalebit” – “Great is the Truth and It Shall Prevail.”



In 1950, the posthumous awarding of the first Medallion to Dr. Thomas P. Hinman was most fitting. Dr. Hinman was a student, an educator and a private practitioner of international renown. He was also president of the National Dental Association, predecessor of the American Dental Association. His greatest contribution to dental education, however, was the founding of the Mid-Winter Clinic in 1913, now the Thomas P. Hinman Dental Meeting.

History of the THOMAS P. HINMAN DENTAL MEETING

The Thomas P. Hinman Dental Meeting is sponsored by the Hinman Dental Society, a non-profit organization. The first Meeting was held in Dr. Thomas P. Hinman and was considered to be the first clinic strictly for serious-minded educational purposes. The Meeting developed a reputation for devotion to detail and hospitality that continues to grow through the years with every meeting.

Born in 1870, Thomas Hinman graduated from Southern Dental College in Atlanta with his Doctor of Dental Surgery degree in 1891.

The first classes for the Atlanta Midwinter Clinic, later renamed the Thomas P. Hinman Dental Meeting, were initially limited to 40 dentists with strict focus on education. The attendee was honor-bound to return to his state dental society and present what he had learned in a formal program.

Today, the focus is still on providing the best possible education, not only for dentists, but also for the entire dental team. The program addresses the needs of general dentists, specialists, hygienists, assistants, office staff, lab techs and students.

The Hinman Dental Society today is comprised of 830 dentist members, primarily located in metropolitan Atlanta. The membership responsibilities include service during the Meeting each year.

The excess revenue of the Meeting is invested and gifted in the form of scholarships to individuals and in contributions to institutions that foster dental education whether at the undergraduate or post-graduate level. As of March 2022, the Society has provided more than \$10 million in total giving.
