The Art and Science of Esthetic Dentistry... Past, Present & Future

In many ways, media has paralleled the dramatic rise of esthetic dentistry through the years. In fact, media coverage has been instrumental in placing our profession in the very center of the world of beauty, and the practice of esthetic dentistry at the forefront of dentistry itself. Esthetics in dentistry has emerged from a secondary consideration in treatment planning to an integral aspect of all disciplines of dentistry.

At the same time, the predictability of osseointegration coupled with the ability of implant supported restorations to cosmetically equal that of conventional crown and bridge has

made implants a viable treatment choice even in the most demanding partially edentulous environment.

However, to integrate esthetics, implants, and esthetic dentistry in day-to-day practice, the focus must move towards expediting the process with simplification and predictability. Fortunately, evolving 3D cone imaging and computer technologies, innovative products and new techniques allow for ever increasing efficiencies. This presentation will cover state-of-the-art integrated esthetic diagnosis and treatment today, and a brief look at the future.

Dr. Ronald Goldstein



Dr. Ronald E. Goldstein is currently Clinical Professor of Oral Rehabilitation at the Medical College of Georgia School of Dentistry. He is a contributor to ten published texts and author of the text *Esthetics In Dentistry*.

He is co-founder and past-president of the American Academy of Esthetic Dentistry and past-president of the International Federation of Esthetic Dentistry. Dr. Goldstein has presented continuing education courses at more than twenty universities and lectured at over 400 dental meetings throughout the world.

Dr. David Garber is a dually trained clinician and professor in the Department of Periodontics as well as in the Department of Oral Rehabilitation at Georgia Health Sciences University. He is a Clinical Professor in the

Department of Prosthodontics at Louisiana State University and a Clinical Professor in the Department of Restorative Dentistry at the University of Texas in San Antonio. He is co-author of *Porcelain Laminate Veneers*, *Bleaching Teeth*, *Porcelain and Composite Inlays and Onlays*, and *Complete Dental Bleaching*.

Dr. Maurice A. Salama received his DMD from the University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine, where he later received his dual specialty certification in Orthodontics and Periodontics as well as his implant training

at the Branemark Center at Penn. He is currently on the faculties of the University of Pennsylvania and Georgia Health Sciences University as Clinical Assistant Professor of Periodontics.
