Tree Enthusiast, Georgia Bulldog Fan Steps Into Presidency

When Dr. Allen French isn't attending Georgia "Bull-dawg" games, you might find him planting trees in the medians of an Alpharetta, Ga. highway. He admits it's a hobby that's become somewhat of a calling and he "went green, before it was cool." As a long-time member of the Rotary Club, he's led many tree planting projects. He has served on the Alpharetta Tree Commission for the past decade and has plated trees at every home he's owned and throughout his community.

Dr. French is more than just a tree enthusiast, he's this year's Hinman Dental Society President and an avid Georgia Bulldog fan. He admits that he likes to bark at games – so much so that he often

loses his voice. He graduated from UGA with a bachelor's degree in psychology and says that if he hadn't gone into dentistry, he would have been a clinical psychologist. After graduating from UGA, he attended the Medical College of Georgia and then joined the U.S. Navy.

He served in the Navy from 1981 to 1990, first as a lieutenant and then a lieutenant commander. Predictable Aesthetic Solutions in Compromised Situations

Dr. Brucia will provide a restorative materials update for 2009. Restorative care demands continuous learning in the areas of material science and restorative technique. It is estimated that more than 80 percent of restorative failures are due to clinical error. The continuous evolution in adhesive materials and techniques combined with the ever-increasing demands for aesthetic restorations have made tooth colored dentistry a quality option for every treatment plan. The numerous choices in restorative materials have confused the clinician as to what is best indicated in a given situation.

Dr. Brucia has lectured internationally on this subject and will guide you through the collection of materials and techniques available today for providing both direct and indirect restorations that will meet your patient's expectations for quality dental care.

Dr. Brucia is a graduate of the University of the Pacific School of Dentistry where he is currently an Assistant Professor of Dental Practice. He is practicing Aesthetic and Restorative dentistry full time in San Francisco, Calif. His focus is to build a partnership between gnathology, occlusion and adhesion. He is also on the faculty of several university based postgraduate programs in aesthetic dentistry. In 2005, Dr. Brucia was elected to membership in the American Academy of Aesthetic Dentistry. He has also been selected by *Dentistry Today* as one of the top clinicians in dental continuing education today.

Dr. Brucia is the co-director of the FACE institute where he chairs the department of Aesthetics and Adhesive Material Science. His focus is to build a partnership between gnathology, occlusion and adhesion. He is on the faculty of several university based postgraduate programs in aesthetic dentistry. He has received Fellowships in the American and International College of Dentists, the Academy of Dentistry International, the Pierre Fauchard Academy and the Doctoral Degree with Delta Sigma Delta. 🌿

6. p. 54, Section 5- Honorary membership: (new sentence) **Honorary membership may be bestowed upon a dentist who has enhanced the profession of dentistry and demonstrated a life of honor. A written nomination...**

7. p. 54, Section 6 – Replace sentence 4 with the following ... **An emeritus member will not pay dues but shall retain the rights of previous membership status.**

8. p. 55, Article II, Section 3 – President-Elect: **The President-Elect shall assist the President in the performance of his duties.** Remove 3rd sentence.

9. p. 56, Section 5 – Secretary: 2nd sentence ... **The Secretary shall keep the records of the Society and perform other such duties as usually pertain to the office.**

10. p. 57, Section 11 – **All new officers, Executive Council Members and committee chairmen shall assume their duties on June 1, the beginning of the fiscal year.**

11. p. 57, Article III, Section 2 – replace with new section. **At the annual meeting members of the Society shall be elected to serve on the Executive Council. They will succeed members who have vacated their seat. The total number on Executive Council shall remain at six (6). No member of the Executive Council shall be permitted to serve for more than two (2) consecutive terms. No term will exceed three (3) years.**

12. p. 58, Article IV – remove Section 3 and Section 4 will now become Section 3. The old Section 3 will now be place under the new Article V – Board of Trustees. See 12a. The remaining Articles will be renumbered.

13. p. 59 NEW Article V, Section 1 – Board of Trustees – insert Section 3 from the former Article IV.

14 - p. 59, Article VI (former Article V), Section 3, 2nd para ... **In addition, members of the Hinman Dental Society shall be elected to serve on the Executive Council (See Article III, Section 2). One (1) member of the Hinman Dental Society shall be elected to serve on the Board of Trustees for six (6) years (See Article V, Section 1).**

15. p. 60, Article VII (former Article VI), Section 2 – **Gold Card** holders, honorary ...

16. p. 60, Section 3, 2nd para, 2nd and 3rd sentence ... **After that time, membership is revoked and a new application must be submitted. No person whose membership has been suspended or revoked shall attend sessions of this Society except by the invitation of the Society.**

17. p. 61, Article VIII (former Article VII) Section 4 – **5. Old business**

18. p. 63, Article XI (former Article X), 2nd para – please remove and place in the Policy & Procedure Manual on page 72 under Executive Office.

19. p. 63, b. **The person has a proprietary, financial or other personal interest of any nature or kind in such product, service or any firm associated with such product or service.**
