Hinman Student Research Symposium

The seventeenth Hinman Student Research Symposium was held October 28-30, 2011, at the historic Peabody Hotel in Memphis, Tennessee. The Symposium featured oral and poster presentations of research projects by dental students and graduate students from dental schools across the nation. At this year's Symposium, 90 students represented 41 dental schools in 24 states, the District of Columbia and 4 Canadian provinces. Eighteen dental students from the University of Tennessee presented their projects and acted as hosts for the Symposium.

The Symposium is sponsored by the University of Tennessee College of Dentistry and co-sponsored by the Hinman Dental Society. The Symposium is also supported in part by grants from the National Institute for Dental and Craniofacial Research (NIDCR), the ADEAGies Foundation, the Procter & Gamble Company and the Tennessee Dental Association Foundation.

Dr. Timothy L. Hottel, Dean, followed by Dr. Franklin Garcia-Godoy, Senior Executive Associate Dean for Research of the University of Tennessee College of Dentistry, opened the meeting. Our own Dr. Dave Lee, President of the Hinman Dental Society, welcomed the participants, praised the Symposium organizers and the student participants, and presented an overview of

the upcoming Hinman Meeting to be held in Atlanta on March 22-24, 2012.

The keynote speaker at the welcoming banquet was Dr. David Wong, Associate Dean of Research at the UCLA School of Dentistry and current President of the American Association for Dental Research. Dr. Wong spoke on "Saliva Diagnostics: Scientific and Clinical Frontiers," presenting a vision of the future of dental practice in which chairside analysis of saliva samples will alert practitioners to oral and systemic health problems and avoid invasive procedures.

Dr. Garcia-Godoy encouraged the students to remain active in research regardless of whether their career paths take them into a dental practice or academics. Dr. Kevin Hardwick, Extramural Training and Career Development Officer of the NIDCR, addressed the participants and emphasized the role of NIDCR

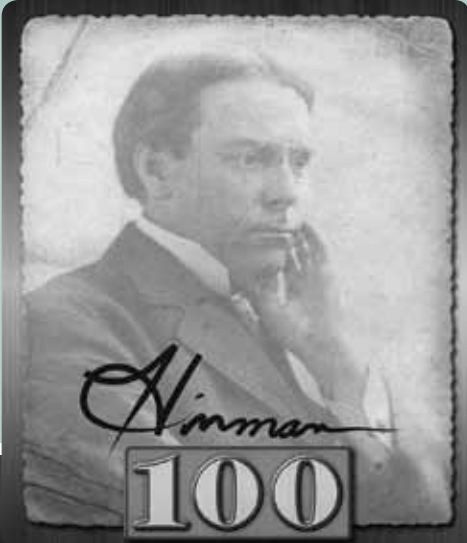
