Hinman Student Research Symposium

The 16th Hinman Student Research Symposium was held October 29 - 31, 2010, at the historic Peabody Hotel in Memphis, Tennessee.

The Symposium featured oral and poster presentations of research projects by dental students and graduate students from dental schools across the nation. At this year's Symposium, 86 students represented 47 dental schools in 29 states, the District of Columbia and three Canadian provinces. Fourteen dental students from the University of Tennessee presented their projects and acted as hosts for the Symposium.

The Symposium is sponsored by the University of Tennessee College of Dentistry and co-sponsored by the Hinman Dental Society, which holds one of the nation's largest continuing dental education meetings each

March in Atlanta. The Symposium is also supported in part by grants from the National Institute for Dental and Craniofacial Research (NIDCR), the ADEAGies Foundation, the Proctor & Gamble Company and the Colgate-Palmolive Company.

Dr. Franklin Garcia-Godoy, Senior Executive Associate Dean for Research at the University of Tennessee College of Dentistry, opened the meeting. Dr. Brian Carpenter, President of the Hinman Dental Society, welcomed the participants, praised the Symposium organizers and the student participants,

and presented an overview of the upcoming Hinman Meeting to be held in Atlanta March 24-26, 2011.

Also attending the Symposium was Dr. Leslie Frieden, Extramural Training Officer at the NIDCR. Dr. Frieden addressed the participants and emphasized the role of NIDCR in supporting research training for dental students and the career options available to future leaders in clinical and translational research.

The keynote speaker at the welcoming banquet was Dr. Dominick P. DePaola, Associate Dean for Academic Affairs at Nova Southeastern College of Dental Medicine. Dr. DePaola spoke on "Recent Advances and Translation to Clinical Practice," addressing the need to accelerate the process of

bringing new scientific discoveries from the laboratory to clinical practice to improve care and oral health worldwide.

Dr. Mustafa Dabbous, Professor of Bioscience Research at the University of Tennessee College of Dentistry, was honored for his foresight in establishing the first Hinman Student

Research Symposium in 1995 and continuing through the years to direct the Symposium and support and encourage student participation in research to advance the dental profession and oral health.

Six awards were given for the most outstanding student presentations, three in clinical research and three in basic science research, in addition to an award from the National Students Research Group (NSRG) of the American Association for Dental Research. Awards were presented by Dr. Franklin Garcia-Godoy and Dr. Brian Carpenter, by Dr. Timothy L. Hottel, Dean of the University of Tennessee College of Dentistry, by Dr. Robert Spears of the Baylor College of Dentistry and former National Faculty Advisor to the NSRG, and by Blake M. Warner, student at Ohio State University and current NSRG President.
