HINMAN 2011 RELIES ON QUALITY EDUCATION & SOUTHERN HOSPITALITY TO ATTRACT MORE THAN 21,600 DENTAL PROFESSIONALS

The theme of the 99th Thomas P. Hinman Dental Meeting was “Quality Continuing Education Served with Southern Hospitality.” With this emphasis on the best in educational programming and hospitality, the meeting attracted 6,054 dentists – the most dentists to attend since the 2006 meeting. Hinman 2011 drew a very large crowd of over 21,600 dental professionals including dentists, dental hygienists, dental assistants, students, lab techs and other industry personnel to the Georgia World Congress Center in Atlanta.

The meeting featured more than 60 leading dental experts, at least 250 courses and workshops, and approximately 400 exhibitors. Across three days, dental professionals learned the latest techniques and sharpened their skills, while socializing with colleagues and friends.

“We are very excited about the turnout this year. We saw more dentists and

their staff in attendance and believe this is due to our exceptional educational program, one of the best technical exhibits in the industry and some truly outstanding networking and social events,” said Dr. Eddie Pafford, Hinman’s 2011 General Chairman.

An exciting addition to the meeting this year was an all-day educational track for dentists called the “Business of Dentistry,” which was held on Saturday during the meeting. More than 170 dentists attended the five sessions, covering everything from taxes and marketing to office image and case acceptance strategies.

In addition to the all-day educational tracks, Hinman’s educational programming offered everything from hands-on oral surgery and digital dental photography to treating medical emergencies and preventive equipment maintenance. Trisha O’Hehir filled a ballroom with 1,647 dental professionals who came to hear “Explaining Bleeding, Bugs and Bad Breath to Patients.” Approximately 1,024 turned out to hear Dr. Carl McManama’s course, “Restoring Endodontically Treated Teeth in 2011.” And, his course titled, “Posterior Composites: What Would GV Black Say?” drew more than 900 dental professionals.

Dr. **John C. Barnes** was named 2010 University of Alabama School of Dentistry Distinguished Alumnus.

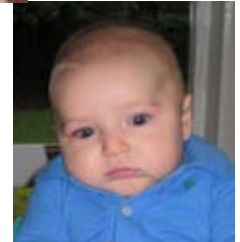
Dr. **Wallace Lail** was named the 2010 Most Outstanding Alumnus at the University of Tennessee School of Dentistry.
