Experience the exciting adventure of whitewater rapids and enjoy the natural beauty of the Pisgah



Event 7 — Chimney Rock Park & Lake Lure Tour with Lunch 9 a.m. - 1:30 p.m.

Meet shuttle in the Atrium Lobby (Vanderbilt Wing, 7th floor) at 8 a.m. [approx. 45-minute scenic drive].

Chimney Rock State Park is a nature lover's paradise. Start the day taking in the spectacular views from the top of Chimney Rock. You can hike or take the



elevator to the top of the 315-foot rock, providing breath-taking views of Hickory Nut Gorge and Lake Lure. There are multiple trails for additional hikes throughout the park, ranging from easy to strenuous, taking you through several different habitat types and waterfalls. Later, enjoy a pontoon boat ride on Lake Lure, taking in the rugged mountain cliffs as they tower around you. Historians will be aboard to share stories of the lake. Gourmet boxed lunch with beverages will be provided. Beer and wine will be available on the shuttle back to the hotel.

Meet in the main lobby at 10:15 a.m. You are responsible for your own transportation. Kid Zip is America's first zipline adventure designed for kids 4 - 10 years old. Adults are allowed only if escorting a child between the ages of 4 - 10 (ages 4 - 6 require an adult escort). This self-guided course includes 9 ziplines and 4 fun climbing elements. The ziplines range from 50 feet to 250 feet long, and 25 feet high to ground level. Weight limit is 225 pounds and closed toe shoes are required. Fee: \$50 adult escort (18+) | \$48 child (ages 4-10) (includes gratuity)

Event 11 – Treetop Adventure Park

11:45 a.m. - 1:45 p.m.

Meet in the main lobby at 11 a.m. You are responsible for your own transportation.

The Treetops Adventure Park is an aerial course with over 77 unique climbing, rolling, walking, jumping, swinging and rappelling challenges anchored to over 30 trees and towering poles tucked into a wooded park. There are 7 courses ranging from beginner to challenging levels. This is



a self-guided tour with Rangers on the ground monitoring group. *Minimum age* is 4 years of age and weight limit is 265 pounds. Ages 4 - 14 must have adult escort. Closed toe shoes are required.

Fee: \$50 adult | \$48 child (ages 4-17) (includes gratuity)
