Getting Ready for Another "Best Hinman Ever"

Life moves pretty quickly these days. Just over two years ago, Hinman 2008 existed in concept only. To optimize growth, successful traditions will be continued, such as 22 new Hinman speakers, more hands-on participation workshops, forums, panels, and special events. If only one of your invitees joins us at the meeting, then 500-600 new doctors will attend. Thank you in advance for taking the time to extend this invitation.

Remember an eight hour day of service is a prerequisite for an invitation to the General Chairman's and President's Reception at the Aquarium.

The honor of representing the Hinman Dental Society at this level is humbling indeed. I thank each of you for your contribution in making Hinman 2008 the next "Best Hinman Ever" and the opportunity of serving as your general chairman.
